



CTR PRAYER PROJECT

Psalm 33:12-Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, the people whom He has chosen for His own inheritance.

Several years ago, I was appalled to hear our nation's President tell another world leader that the USA is not a Christian nation. If he were to say the same thing today, I would have to agree with him. Today I heard a sermon given by Pastor Bill Meiter of Arizona Community Church in Tempe. He told us he believes prosperity has led our younger generation to grow up with a demand for more and more entitlements. Instead of being fully dependent on God or neighbors

for their needs, they have become totally dependent on government. As a result, their work ethic has suffered; college students graduate with a debt average of \$26,000; they believe socialism is the way to stay blessed; if they attend church at all, they seek out "entertainment churches", where the Gospel is seldom preached and self-denial is unheard of; many grow up in homes where there is no discipline, attend school where prayer is not allowed, and attend colleges where unbiblical ideology is taught. Many of today's young people are protesting in the streets, attacking and killing police officers, addicted to drugs or alcohol, slaughtering babies in the womb, redefining marriage, and rewarding criminals. Pastor Meiter reminded us that to be blessed by the Lord, a nation must be obedient to the Lord. It's not enough to just acknowledge that the Lord exists. If we allow a haphazard approach to the Lord's warnings to become standard here in the USA, we put our nation at risk of being wiped off the face of the earth, like Sodom and Gomorrah and other nations in Old Testament times. We must remember that God is under no obligation to delay His judgment. We are rejecting God's Laws and are passing unrighteous, manmade laws where evil is called good and good is called evil. Pastor Meiter also cautioned us, saying that we are ignorant to think we can disobey God and expect Him to look the other way. God's Church simply must not resemble the world; it must remain pure. If we're not doing it already, it's time for us to pray for the Holy Spirit to bring repentance to this land, and especially to our hearts.

Praying in One Accord-We have two choices: We can pray in one accord with God's Laws, or pray in one accord with the Anti-Christ. Both demand our obedience.

Accord Prayer-Lord Christ, You established Your Church to offer an alternative to worldly thoughts and practices; help us refrain from the temptation to mix the two. In Your Name we pray. Amen.

Prayer of Thanksgiving-Merciful Father, thank You for warning us of the impending doom awaiting those who spurn You; thank You for leading us to repentance through the power of Your Holy Spirit. Amen.
