





CtR Prayer Project

James 1:22-Do not merely listen to the word and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.

Just considering a temptation is not a sin; giving in to it is. When King David beheld Bathsheba, he knew she was married and off limits to him (Jewish monarchs were supposed to have only one wife), but he gave in to that temptation and ended up adding murder to his list of transgressions. The problem with giving in to temptation is the guilt, cover-up, and endless consequences the perpetrator must suffer. Currently, our nation is giving into a lot of temptation. Our nation is going through a period of unrest, anguish, fear, doubt, worry, and mistrust as a consequence. And that is leading people to say and do things that go against God's will and His ordinances. We're unwilling to listen to both sides of an argument and come to a compromise. We watch the news and our blood begins to boil. We listen to half-truths and are filled with fear or doubt. We can't see a solution to a situation, so we worry about the future. And we hear so many lies today, that we don't know whom we should trust. Who or what is to blame? It's not the politicians. It's not the government. It's not law enforcement. It's not the color of our skin--- although we're tempted to point a finger of blame at any or all of these. The real culprit is Satan, the father of lies, the great deceiver, and the accuser of mankind. So, how do we avoid the temptation to follow Satan instead of the Spirit of Truth? We do it by not just being familiar with God's Word, but by obeying it. His Word tells us to love one another (John

13:34); we disobey when we spew hatred and falsely accuse others of being racist, xenophobic, or divisive. His Word tells us to forgive others (Matt. 6:14); we disobey when we hold grudges, seek revenge, and attempt to get others to agree with us, even if we may be wrong. His Word tells us that fear is not from God (1 John 4:18); we disobey when we depend on other people or manmade solutions to protect us. His Word tells us worry is a failure on our part to place our unfailing trust in God (Matt. 6:31-34); we disobey when we trust ourselves or other humans, then succumb to worry. We agree with our Bibles, say “amen” to sermons, and call ourselves Christians, but is there really enough evidence to convict us?

Praying in One Accord-When we commit to being doers of God’s Word, not just hearers, we will likely be in one accord with the Living Word.

Accord Prayer-Lord Christ, You never sinned. Obedience was a top priority for You. Please help us make it our priority, too. In Jesus’ Name we pray. Amen.

Prayer of Thanksgiving-Heavenly Father, thank You for knowing that human nature would make it difficult for us to be doers of Your Word. Thank You for allowing the sacrifice of Your only Son to enable us to be forgiven when we fail to obey. Lead us into repentance. Amen.
