## CtR Prayer Project

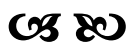
**Genesis 2:8-9**-The Lord God planted a garden toward the east, in Eden, and there He placed the man whom He had formed. Out of the ground the Lord caused to grow every tree that is pleasing to the sight and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

Our entire family enjoys playing table games. My husband and I grew up playing Go Fish, Rummy, Canasta, and Pinochle. Our children grew up playing Monopoly, Dominoes, Yahtzee, and Trivial Pursuit. Our grandchildren like playing Pigs, Apples to Apples, and the Marble Game (aka Sorry). Some of these games have slight variances in the rules, depending on whose house we are playing at or the number of people playing, but we all agree that the manufacturer of the games gets to write the rules. The Bible tells us that God planted a garden in Eden, so God was entitled to make the rules governing the garden. (I should say rule, because there was only one thing in the Garden they were forbidden to eat: the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.) Satan, the father of lies, tempted Eve to change the rule, convincing her that God made the rule for selfish reasons and that there would be no consequence--that she would not die. We refer to this story as "The Fall of Man", and to the tendency to sin that all mankind is born with as "original sin". My Bible Dictionary defines sin as "anything in the creature which does not express, or which is contrary to, the holy character of the Creator". It adds that "the essence of sin is living independently of God. Adam and Eve, of their own free will, chose to corrupt the holy, godly character with which God originally endowed His creation." And God had already warned them of His punishment for what He considered treason: It was death. Satan is already condemned to the Second Death--that is, the Lake of Fire--for committing treason in the heavenly realm. We Christians tend to think of Christ's sacrifice on the Cross as being rather easy for the Son of God, because He knew that in three days, He would be raised from the dead. But, try to see this from God's perspective. Every sin that Jesus bore on the Cross was an act of human treason. And He didn't just take to the Cross the treasonous acts of you and me; He took to the Cross the treasonous acts--past, present, and future--of every man, woman, and child who has ever lived or will ever live on this planet. The next time you are tempted to disregard God's rules, remember this: There may not be sufficient evidence to convict you of being a Christian, but God knows full well that there is
