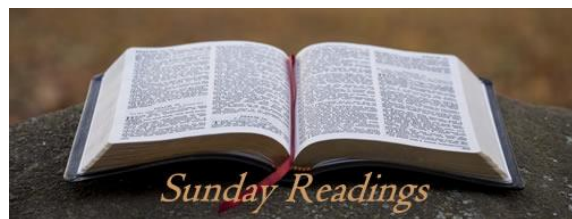
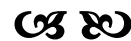
**Next Parish Council Meeting**

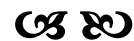

## CtR Prayer Project

**Hebrews 4:16-Therefore, let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.**

I was born tongue-tied. I'm certain there are some--my hubby included--who wish the doctor who delivered me had never discovered that, but the doctor could tell the moment I uttered my first cry, and God had plans for me to use my voice for teaching, singing, and leading various organizations.

Some people are “tongue-tied”, even though they weren’t born that way. They find it very difficult to talk to someone they can’t see. Our Father God sacrificed His Son so we could be restored to relationship with Him. He tore the heavy curtain in the temple upon Christ’s death to show man he was no longer separated from the Holy of Holies. God wants us to talk with Him. I used to think He was too busy healing people or saving people to care about my petty concerns, but I’ve since learned that He is our “Abba” Father--our “Daddy”, and He loves it when we ask Him for help with whatever concerns us. (Right now, that involves getting up and down stairs.) I used to pray for God to keep my loved ones safe, but now I find myself asking Him to guide them in their God-appointed ministries, or to open their eyes to the truth about matters that concern them. Sometimes the words that come out of my mouth get all garbled, and anyone listening would think I am still tongue-tied, but God knows my thoughts before I even speak them, so I needn’t worry about that. The Scripture for today’s Accord Prayer was chosen because it reminds us of three important points about our prayers: 1) Prayers help us obtain mercy; 2) Prayers help us find grace; and 3) We can approach the throne of grace boldly. The Rev. Dr. Charles F. Stanley says **MERCY** means we are forgiven--that when we confess our sins, **God does not give us what we deserve**. Dr. Stanley says **GRACE** means that **God gives us what we do not deserve**--healing, comfort, love, and the like. And **BOLDLY** means that when we pray, we have an **Advocate**, Jesus Christ the Righteous, turning our tongue-tied requests into far more than we can ask for or imagine.

**Praying in One Accord**--Even when our personal requests are not in one accord with God’s will for us, Jesus aligns them with God’s perfect will for us.

**Accord Prayer**--Lord Christ, we need an Advocate desperately; please help us to daily speak our concerns to You, even though You already know our every thought and prayer before we speak it. This helps confirm our need for Your daily help. In Your Name we pray. Amen.

**Prayer of Thanksgiving**--Abba Father, thank You for making us righteous through Your Son, Jesus Christ, and thank You for always hearing and answering the prayers of the righteous. Amen.
